

Pilgrim Branch MBC Church Profile

Pilgrim Branch Missionary Baptist Church (PBMBC), located in the Kohrville area of Houston, Texas, is a historic church that has served the Kohrville community for over 150 years since its founding in 1869. The church was established by a group of believers who came together to share the message of Jesus Christ and build a strong faith community. Since then, Pilgrim Branch has continued its mission of spreading God's Word and serving the surrounding community through worship, ministry, and outreach. Several families played an important role in establishing the church, including the Woods and Blackstock families. Reverend Phil Blackstock served as the church's first pastor, and Willis Woods donated land for the relocation of the church and cemetery.

At its highest point in recent years, Pilgrim Branch Missionary Baptist Church averaged approximately 75 in worship attendance. Pilgrim Branch Missionary Baptist Church is mortgage-free, with only monthly utilities and the occasional repairs. Being mortgage-free enables Pilgrim Branch to manage its finances carefully to support its ministries and outreach. For 2026, the church's annual budget is approximately \$169,764.96, which helps support church activities and community services.

Today, the members of Pilgrim Branch Missionary Baptist Church represent different generations within the congregation. The church recognizes that many young families live in the surrounding Kohrville and northwest Harris County area and seeks to reach them with the message of Jesus Christ.

Pilgrim Branch Missionary Baptist Church is governed by an administrative body consisting of a Board of Directors authorized to provide leadership for the church. The board is composed of a minimum of five (5) members and a maximum of seven (7) members, including the Pastor, who serves as the Moderator.

The Pastor serves as the Moderator of the Board of Directors, and the Chairman of the Board of Directors serves as the Moderator of the Board in the absence of, or upon the request of, the Pastor. The Secretary is responsible for maintaining official correspondence and ensuring that accurate records are kept for all meetings of the Board of Directors.

The mission of the church is to promote Christianity, increase biblical knowledge, spread God's Word, and lead people to Jesus Christ while caring for the bereaved, the needy, and the sick.

Pilgrim Branch Missionary Baptist Church is affiliated with the Union Baptist Association and the Texas Baptist Association. Worship services include Sunday Early Service at 8:00 AM, Sunday School at 9:45 AM, Sunday Morning Service at 11:00 AM, and Wednesday Bible Study at 7:00 PM.

The church also offers several ministries, including Youth, Praise Dance, Marriage, Women's, Brotherhood, Young Lions, Choir, Pastor's Aide, Intercessory Prayer, Sick and Bereavement, and Seniors Ministries.

Overall, Pilgrim Branch Missionary Baptist Church continues to serve the Kohrville community through worship, fellowship, and outreach while remaining committed to sharing the message of Jesus Christ.
